YOUNG SINGER AGE 17 - 22

-Preselection with VideoRecording: n. 1 opera aria
Editing of the recordings is not allowed

-Final: Maximum 10 minutes. The music program is free
The final will be held on 6 April from 12 pm to 1 pm at the Casina Pompeiana-Villa Comunale in Naples

THE NEAPOLITAN MASTERS PRIZE AGE 20 - 36

-Preselection with VideoRecording: n. 1 opera aria
Editing of the recordings is not allowed

-Semifinal: n. 2 opera arias (max 10 min)
Be allowed repeat works performed in the Preselection round.

-Final: n. 1 obligatory aria, candidates must sing an aria chosen by the archive that will be performed with the orchestra (web site download archive)

The winners of the International Competitions (1 Prize) will go directly to the semifinal round attaching a certificate

All arias must be in the original language and k
